

Rules and regulations

By using the digital makerspace Digiverstas you commit to follow these rules.

- 1. The equipment is meant to be used on a self-service basis. If you have not used the equipment before, please reserve an appointment for a guidance session through Varaamo, phone (08 558 47337) or email (info.kirjasto@ouka.fi).
- 2. If you need help using the equipment for the entire duration of your appointment, please bring your personal assistant with you.
- 3. Make sure to read the user manual. Follow the guidelines and ask for advice from the library staff if you are unsure how to use the equipment correctly and safely.
- 4. Let the library staff know about any errors or defects of the equipment or materials, or if they are not operating correctly.
- 5. When your appointment ends, the equipment needs to be ready to shut down or ready for the next user.
- 6. Use the equipment at your own risk. Oulu City Library is not responsible for the damage caused by the users.
- 7. Oulu City Library is not responsible for the possible damage caused by the manufactured items.
- 8. The printers and cutters are to be used only with the materials provided by the Oulu City Library. The materials are charged according to the list of prices.
- 9. The user is liable to compensate if the equipment is broken or damaged due to a failure to follow the guidelines or careless behaviour.
- 10. Manufacturing weapons or any kind of items meant to harm others is prohibited.
- 11. Clean up after yourself and leave everything in good condition for the next users.
- 12. Eating and drinking in the proximity of the equipment is prohibited.
- 13. The digital makerspace is not a production line. Please do not reserve the equipment for mass production of items.
- 14. The reservation is cancelled if the user is late for more than 15 minutes. All appointments end at least 5 minutes before the library is closed.
- 15. You can have only one appointment for one makerspace equipment at a time.
- 16. Users under 15 years of age need a permission from a parent or a guardian for independent use of the equipment.
