Experimentation we learn through "Bad ideas workshop", removing a fear for mistakes, creating safe environment for failure

Curiosity and experimentation: bad ideas workshop; weekly tasks/themes to investigate or do the way the learner wants; grading yourself in your work

Grit, Create short term Goals, show examples, create a culture of grit/persistence

Let students start approaching the subject from their hobbies, something that they think is really interesting already to begin with. When students feel that they are successful, they are more likely

Working in entrepreneurial way

Most of the skills are part of the current curriculum. The problem is that how well we are reaching the goals is not evaluated and therefore not seen as important and not worked on systematically.

Work on how they feel when they achieve hard work. Let them know that they must be proud of themselves and remember that they have fun.

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We can teach perseverance and patience so that we don't give solutions to problems or long tasks immediately. A better way is to ask questions and help students so that they have to think their own.

Persistence; Make the development visible. Why are we doing something? Give clear answers.

Work in projects so they can practice patience and explain, make it clear for the students, how the subjects are involved

It is possible to teach these skills in all school subjects.. Maybe it could be a start for the lesson planning process of the teacher that he/she would start thinking the skill

I think that learning happens better in small groups, by dividing the students in small groups and mixing the groups the possibilities to learn are great
