Oulu-opisto is a community college owned by the city of Oulu. It is the third-oldest and currently fourth-largest community college in Finland. It was founded 110 years ago and provides nearly 50 000 hours of teaching annually. The community college is open to all ages and groups, but the vast majority of our students (76%) are adults.

We have 32 full-time staff members and almost 300 part-time teachers. We are a prolific provider of adult education and a major employer too, with over 12 100 students total. Oulu-opisto has six departments of instruction: languages, music, visual arts, handicrafts, sports and wellness, dance and theater, as well as lectures and other subjects (home economics, interior design, environment, history etc).
